4. Title Motor vehicle registration fees for emergency services

5. Summary/Purpose: Increases, effective July 1, 2002, from two dollars per year (two -for-life) to four dollars per year (four -for-life) the motor vehicle registration surcharge used to support emergency medical services. From July 1, 2002, through June 30, 2004, the additional two dollars per year will be used for emergency medical services, fire responders, and public safety purposes, with the existing two dollars per year continuing to be used to support emergency medical services. On and after July 1, 2004, all revenues will be used to support emergency medical services.

8. Fiscal implications: This bill would require the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to collect an additional two -dollar surcharge on all motor vehicle registrations, per §46.2 -694, effective July 1, 2002 (FY2003). This, in turn, would allow DMV to increase its annual collections by an estimated \$13.0 million in FY2003 and \$13.3 million in FY2004, which would be transferred to the general fund to support public safety and emergency response purposes. DMV estimates that it would incur minimal expenses for programming costs associated with the implementation of this legislation. Revenue generated on and after July 1, 2004, (FY2005) will be used to support emergency medical services per §46.2 -694.
