5. Summary/Purpose:

This legislation would allow the Assistive Technology Loan Fund Authority (ATLFA) to develop a loan program that expands its current ability to provide assistance in the purchase of assistive technology equipment. The program will allow loans be made available to people with disabilities for other equipment which is designed to enable persons with disabilities to become more independent or more productive members of the community. The Board of the ATLFA may also delegate loan committee the authority to review and approve or deny loan applications, in accordance with criteria established by the Board and subject to the Board's ratification at its next regular meeting.
