RequirestheCommonwealthTransportationBoardtoestablish regulationsregardingthe installation,maintenance,andremovalofroadsidememorials,plaques,andotherdeviceswithin theright -of-wayofanystatehighwaythatcommemoratethememoryofpersonskilledinvehicle crashes. Anypersonwhoinstallsany plaque,device,sign,object,material,orothermemorial withintheright -of-wayofanyhighwaycontrolledbytheDepartment,exceptinaccordancewith criteriaestablishedasprovidedinthissection,maybeassessedacivilpenaltyofnomorethan \$100. AllcivilpenaltiescollectedunderthissectionshallbepaidintotheHighwayMaintenance andOperatingFund.

## 8. Fiscalimplications:

According to the Department of Transportation, the recould be an expenditure associated with administrating the program. Although the recould be a fiscal impact on the department in establishing the criteria for roads ide memorials, it likely could be absorbed within the department's current budget.

Inaddition, the establishme nto fde signand installation criteria for road side memorials would create are sponsibility to license, manage and maintain them. Each memorial may require aland use permit, which would necessitate are view process on the size, markings, wording, etc. of marker and its location within the right of-way. Each residency would need to be aware of the

administrative, management, and maintenance processes, and be actively involved in the processes.

The cost of a landuse permitis approximately \$55.00, which would be required for each memorial. Controls and processes may also need to be established to bill private citizens for this permit fee and any potential maintenance costs.

Approximately1,000personsarekilledeachyearonVirginia'shighway s.Ifthememorial programisimplemented,thenitisestimatedthat,initially,10to20percentoftheaffected familiesmaywantahighwaymemorial.Revenuescollectedtooffsetdirectcostscouldbe \$8,250(15percentoffatalitiestimespermitfee sof\$55.00).

Also, there could be additional revenue generated from the assessment of a \$100 civil penalty, but this will depend on the number of instances in which memorials are established that do not meet the criteria, and the number of persons caugh two are inviolation of the roads ide memorial criteria. The additional revenue may be minimal. Also, the bill specifies that the additional revenue be paid to the Highway Maintenance and Operating Fund. Civil penalties of this type are usually deposited to the Literary Fund.
