5. Summary/Purpose:

Thesubstitutebilladds adifferentdefinitionof"fairmarketrentalvalue"asitrelatestorent paidbygamingorganizationsforcommercialpremisesfortheconductofcharitablegaming,but removestherequirementintheoriginalbillthattheCharitableGamingCommissionad opta formulatodeterminefairmarketrentalvalue.ThesubstitutebillalsoextendsuntilDecember 31,2002,themoratoriumthatpreventstheCharitableGamingCommissionfromdenying, revoking,orsuspendingagamingorganization'spermittooperateon thebasisoffailuretomeet "useofproceeds"requirements.*Inaddition,thesubstitutebillclarifiesconditionsrelated jackpotsof"winner -take-all"bingogames.

8. Fiscalimplications : The billhasnodirectfiscalimpactontheCharitableGamingCommission (CGC) or on the gaming organization sitregulates.

Theoriginal bill, which required the Charitable Gaming Commission to adopt a formulato determine fairmark etvalue of rents for commercial bing ohalls, would have had the likely effect of increasing the ability of charitable gaming organizations to meet the "use of proceeds" requirement * while still enabling landlords of bing ohalls to earn are as on able profit. Some 65 percent of gaming organizations that conduct bing oin commercial bing ohalls do not meet "use of proceeds" requirements. The substitute bill has no impact on organizations that rent commercial bing ohalls.

Theprovisioninthesubstitutebillthatprevents theCGCfromrevokingthepermitof agamingorganizationthatdoesnotmeet"useofproceeds"requirementsmayhavean indirectnegativeeffectonthecharitiesthatreceivecontributionsfromgaming organizations, butitisnotpossibletoquantifyorde terminetheexactimpact.

* Use of proceeds: The requirement that a certain percentage of gaming receipts be donated to a legitimate charity.
