Summary/Purpose:** The bill prohibits employers from (i) soliciting or requiring agenetic test, and (ii) making an adverse employment decision affecting a current or prospective employees olely on the basis of the results of agenetic test. "Genetic test" is defined as a test for determining the presence or absence of genetic characteristics in an individual in order to diagnose agenetic characteristic. The bill creates a private cause of action for an aggrieved individual, and the court may award actual and punitive damages in junctive relief, and attorney's fees.
