4. Title Revisions in the election and voter registration laws.

5. Summary/Purpose:

SB113 modifies and clarifies various provisions relating to investigations of election law violations, officers of election and poll books, postponement of elections in emergencies, and voter registration and absentee voting procedures. This bill incorporates a number of recommendations of the Joint Subcommittee Studying Virginia's Election Process and Voting Technologies (HJR681/SJR363 --2001).
