4. **Title** Driver's licenses, temporary driver's permits, etc.

5. **Summary/Purpose:**

Driver's licenses, temporary driver's permits, learner's permit, motorcycle learner's permits, commercial driver's licenses, and special identification cards. Provides that, in applying for a driver's license, temporary driver's permit, learner's permit, or motorcycle learner's permit, an immigration visa that expires one year or less from the date of application shall not be acceptable evidence of the applicant's name or date of birth and, if the applicant presents a foreign passport as evidence of his name and date of birth, further requires that the Department of Motor Vehicles must require the applicant for any of these documents to submit at least two proofs that he is a resident of Virginia. Neither an immigration visa nor a signed written statement, whether or not such statement is notarized, wherein the maker of the statement vouches for the Virginia residency of the applicant, shall be an acceptable proof of Virginia residency.
