5. Summary/Purpose: **This bill was amended and engrossed as amended:** Driver's licenses, temporary driver's permits, learner's permit, motorcycle learner's permits, commercial driver's licenses, and special identification cards. As amended, the bill provides that, in applying for a driver's license, temporary driver's permit, learner's permit, or motorcycle learner's permit, an application must include, in addition to previously required information, the name of the county city or town in which the applicant resides, and whether or not the applicant is a citizen of the U.S. An immigration visa shall not be acceptable evidence of the applicant's name or date of birth and, if the applicant presents a foreign passport or some form of identification issued by another state, the Department must require the applicant to submit at least two proofs of Virginia residency. Neither an immigration visa nor a signed written statement, or affidavit, wherein the maker of the statement vouches for the Virginia residency of the applicant, shall be an acceptable proof of Virginia residency.
