**5. Summary/Purpose:** ThisbillwouldaddMCADormedian -chainAcyl -CoAdehydrogenase deficiency,totheeightnewbornscreeningteststhatarerequiredforeveryinfantwhoisborn intheCommonwealthtopreventmentalretardation,permanentdisability,ordeath.Italso requirestheVirginiaDepartmentofHealth(VDH)and DivisionofConsolidatedLaboratory Services(DCLS)toworkwithaprivate,nonprofitorganizationtopurchaseatleastone tandemmassspectrometerpriortobeginningtesting.ItwouldbecomeeffectiveJanuary1, 2004.

- **7. Budgetamendmentnecessary:** No.Theagencycanrequestthatitsappropriationtobe administrativelyincreasedtoaddressanyinitialexpendituresinFY2004.Additional appropriationforFY2005canbeprovidedinthe2004 -06biennialbudgettoaccountfor actualexpenditures.
- **8. Fiscalimplications:** The Division of Consolidated Laboratory Services (DCLS) has indicated that there is a national trend to perform this newborntest. Out of the 40 other states that perform newborns creening, about eight have already required the MCAD test. In addition, a tandem mass spectrometer (required to perform MCAD testing) can be used for other newborns creening tests. DCLS estimates the cost of a tandem mass spectrometer to be about \$250,000, which includes setup expenses. The agency maintains it would require on et and em

mass spectrometer for the program's first year (FY2004) and an additional unit for subsequent years (FY2005 and beyond) to ensure continuity of service. However, Virginia Department of Health (VDH) has reported that the March of Dimes may provide the first tandem mass spectrometer, thus reducing the FY2004 fiscal impact. In addition, DCLS will enter into a master equipment lease to purchase the second tandem mass spectrome terover a five-year period (\$55,000 per year).

Inadditiontoequipment,DCLSindicatedthatitwouldrequiretwopositions(ananalytical chemistandscientist)inforthefirstyear(FY2004)tosetuptheequipmentandperformthe necessarytests.It isestimatedthatthesepositionswouldcostabout\$167,000forsalaryand benefitsforFY2004(assuming14payperiodsbasedonJanuary1effectivedate)and \$286,000inthesubsequentyears.DCLSwillrequireanadditionalscientistposition(about \$104,000)inFY2005tohandletheanticipatedincreaseintestingandoperationofthesecond tandemmassspectrometer.DCLSindicatedthatitscostforsupplieswouldincreasebyabout \$110,000eachyear(\$55,000forFY2004).

TheHealthDepartmentmain tainsthatitwouldrequireawageemployeeinFY2004toassist inthedevelopmentofeducationalmaterial,trainhealthcareproviders,andwritefollow -up procedures.Basedonnumberoffollow -uptests,currentstaffwouldassumethis responsibilityin thesecondyear.Thecostofawageregisterednursepositionisestimatedat \$40,000.Thecurrentbrochureswouldhavetobere -writtenincorporatingthisnewtest.A physicianwillalsobenecessarytoensuremedicalaccuracyofthebrochureandothe reducationalmaterial.ExistingVDHmedicalstaffwouldmeetthisrequirement.The brochurewillneedtobetranslatedinSpanish.Thecostofbrochuredevelopmentand printingintwolanguagesisestimatedat\$39,000.Oncethisprogramisimplemented ,current staffwouldassumetheseresponsibilities.

CurrentlyDCLSchargeshospitalsfornewborntestingkits. Theagencyanticipatesthatitwill increasethefeeassociatedwiththesekitstofundtheincreasedcostsofeducation, equipment, and personnel related to MCAD testing.
