**5. Summary/Purpose:** The billadds definitions of "companion animal rescue agenc y"and "fosterhome," and establishes requirements for operating companion animal rescue agencies andfosterhomes. The billalso sets outseparate registration requirements for companion animalrescueagenciesandanimalpoundsandsheltersthatusefost animalrescueagencies are not inspected by the State Veterinarian prior to accepting animals andarenotrequiredtomeetshelterregulationssetforthbytheDepartment.Instead,a companionanimalrescueagencymustself -certifyan dinspectanyfosterhomesusedpriorto placingananimaltodetermineifthehomemeetsthebasicownerstandardsofcareassetout in§3.1 -796.68plusadditionalrequirements. Theself -certification and inspection reports are tobefiledwiththeSta teVeterinarian.Companionanimalrescueagenciesmustregisterwith theDepartmentannuallyandfosterhomesmustself -certifytwiceayearthattheyare continuingtomeetthebasicownerstandardsofcarewiththecompanionanimalrescue agency. Pound sandanimal shelters that use foster homestokeepanimal saccepted by the poundorsheltermustinspectthosefosterhomespriortoplacingananimal. The fosterhomes mustself -certifytwiceayearthattheycontinuetomeetthebasicownerstandardso fcare. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services may require an appropriate fee for registrationasacompanionanimalrescueagencyorfosterhome.

- **8. Fiscalimplications:** The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services estimates that two full-time positions, administrative costs, and travelex penses are needed to implement the registration and monitoring requirements of the ill. The estimated costs are:

The provisions of the bill allow the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to establish and collect are gistration fee from each companion rescue agency and each foster homeused by an animal shelter, an imal pound, or companion animal rescue agency. The department proposes a fee of \$100 per year for rescue agencies and shelters and \$50 per year for each foster home. It is estimated that 300 companion animal rescue agencies and shelters and \$1,160 foster homes will be registered.

Persons found violating the provisions of this legislation may be found guilty of a class 4 misdemean or and subject to a fine of not more than \$250.
