Summary/Purpose:Requiresthe SuperintendentofStatePolicetorequireeachlocaland statepoliceofficer,duringthecourseofhisofficialduties,tocollectcertaininformation pertainingtotrafficstops,includingtherace,ethnicity,color,ageandgenderofthealleged trafficoffender,andtorecordthespecificreasonforthestop,whetherthepersonwas interrogated,chargedorarrested,andwhetherawrittencitationorwarningwasissued.Police officersmustalsoindicatethespecifictrafficviolationcommitted.Police officers participatinginthecollectionofsuchtrafficdataandinformationhavebeengrantedcivil immunityforactsandomissionsduringtheperformanceoftheirofficialduties,absentgross negligenceorwillfulmisconduct.Thebillalsorequirest hedevelopmentofastatewide databaseforcollecting,correlating,analyzing,interpreting,andreportingdataandinformation generatedthroughsuchtrafficstopreports.

Fiscalimplications: Inordertoimplementtheproposedlegislation,theDepartmento fState Policeestimatesthatitwillrequireapositionineachofthe48AreaOffices.These48 positionswillberesponsiblefordataentryofstatisticsreceivedfromstopsmadebystate troopersassignedtotheirareaoffice.AlsoreflectedunderIt em6aretheone -timeequipment costsforthese48positionsandthecostsassociatedwiththedevelopmentandmaintenanceof anautomatedsystemtocollecttherequiredinformation.Thisestimatedimpact <u>doesnot</u> includeanycostsforpossiblelossofst atetrooperproductivity(trooperstakingadditional timepereachtrafficstoptocollectandreportthisdata)orthefiscalimpactonlocalpolice agencies(datacollection,entryandelectronicallysubmittingdatatotheDepartmentofState Police). Thefiscalimpactofthislegislationcouldbepartiallyavoidedifresourcesarecommittedto theStatewideAreaRadioSystem(STARS).ThissystemcouldpermittheDepartmentof StatePolice,aswellasthelocallawenforcementagencies,tosubmitrequ ireddatadirectlyto theDepartmentofStatePolicefromtheallegedtrafficoffensescene.Iffunded,thesystem couldbeprovidingsomeracialprofilingdatafromstateandlocalpoliceofficersinlessthan twoyears(theentirestateinabout6years ).
