Summary/Purpose: CommonwealthHea lthResearchBoard;powersoftheBoard.Provides thatnomorethansixpercentofthemovingaverageofthemarketvalueoftheFund calculatedoverthepreviousfiveyears,onaone -yeardelayedbasis,netofanyadministrative feeassessedbytheBoard oftheVirginiaRetirementSystem,maybeexpendedinacalendar year.Currentlaw*providesthattheannualincomeoftheFund,excludinggainsonthesale ofinvestments,maybeexpendedannually.ThebillalsoauthorizestheBoardtohiresuch staff asisnecessaryandtofixthesalariesandcompensationofsuchstaff,whichshallbepaid fromtheCommonwealthHealthResearchFund.TheexecutivesecretarytotheBoardisno longerrequiredtobetheDirectoroftheStateCouncilofHigherEducation forVirginia.

- **11. Other comments:** State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) provides staff support (not paid by the fund) to the Board and the Virginia Retirement System (VRS) provides investment management services (paid by the fund) to the Board. Currently, the Board is not allowed to hire staff or pay for expenses such as phones, rent, etc. The Board is currently required to have SCHEV provide administrative support services and would prefer to conduct its own business. This bill would free SCHEV from some of the administrative burdens, such as hiring an administrator and managing the logistical operations, and allow the Board to conduct its own affairs.
