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- 5. Summary/Purpose: CommonwealthHea lthResearchBoard;powersoftheBoard.Provides thatnomorethansixpercentofthemovingaverageofthemarketvalueoftheFund calculatedoverthepreviousfiveyears,onaone -yeardelayedbasis,netofanyadministrative feeassessedbytheBoard oftheVirginiaRetirementSystem,maybeexpendedinacalendar year.CurrentlawprovidesthattheannualincomeoftheFund,excludinggainsonthesaleof investments,maybeexpendedannually.ThebillalsoauthorizestheBoardtohiresuchstaff asisnecessaryandtofixthesalariesandcompensationofsuchstaff,whichshallbepaidfrom theCommonwealthHealthResearchFund.TheexecutivesecretarytotheBoardisno longerrequiredtobetheDirectoroftheStateCouncilofHigherEducation forVirginia.
- 6. FiscalImpactEstimatesare: Insignificant
- **7. Budgetamendmentnecessary:** Yes.Ifpassed,thisbillwouldstrikeItem169(Financial AssistanceforHealthResearch(40700)AdministrationServices(40701))fromSCHEV's budget.Anequiva lentitemwouldneedtobeestablishedelsewhereinthebudget.
- 8. Fiscalimplications: Currently,thepart -timeadministratorispaidfromthefund,and SCHEVstaffprovidesadditionaladministrativesupportasneeded,withSCHEVabsorbing anyassociat edindirectoverheadcosts. This bill would remove SCHEV from performance of these duties. VRS manages the fundinvestments. Generally, the amount available for award is currently dependent upon volatile market conditions and the revised formula would probe terplanning and less fluctuation in funds available for award.
- **9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** State Council of Higher Education, VirginiaRetirementSystemandtheCommonwealthHealthResearchBoard
- **10. Technicalamendmentnecessary:** No.EngrossedbillcontainsSenateAmendmentthat providesforCHRBtocarryforwardanyamountuptosixpercentofthemovingaverageof themarketvalueoftheFundthatisnotexpendedinagivencalendaryeartoanyother subsequentcalendaryear.
- **11. Other comments:** State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) provides staff support (not paid by the fund) to the Board and the Virginia Retirement System (VRS) provides investment management services (paid by the fund ) to the Board. Currently, the Boardis not allowed to hire staff or payfor expenses such as phones, rent, etc. The Board is currently required to have SCHEV provide administrative support services and would prefer

 $to conduct its own business. \ This bil lwould free SCHEV from some of the administrative burdens, such a shiring an administrator and managing the logistical operations, and allow the Board to conduct its own affairs.$
