4. Title CommonwealthHealthResearchBoard;powersoftheBoard.

5. Summary/Purpose: CommonwealthHealthResearchBoard;powersoftheBoard.P rovides thatnomorethansixpercentofthemovingaverageofthemarketvalueoftheFund(The CommonwealthHealthResearchBoardFund)calculatedoverthepreviousfiveyears,ona one-yeardelayedbasis,netofanyadministrativefeeassessedbytheBo ardoftheVirginia RetirementSystem,maybeexpendedinacalendaryear.Currentlaw*providesthatthe annualincomeoftheFund,excludinggainsonthesaleofinvestments,maybeexpended annually.ThebillalsoauthorizestheBoardtohiresuchsta ffasisnecessaryandtofixthe salariesandcompensationofsuchstaff,whichshallbepaidfromtheCommonwealthHealth ResearchFund.TheexecutivesecretarytotheBoardisnolongerrequiredtobetheDirector oftheStateCouncilofHigherEducati onforVirginia.

*Clarificationofcurrentlaw:

"notmore than an amount equal to nine type r cent of the annual income..., net of any administrative fee assessed..., shall be expended for any purpose permitted...."

Fiscalimplications: Currently,thepart -timeadministratorispaidfromthefund,and SCHEVstaffprovideadditionaladministrativesupportasneeded,withSCHEVabsorbing anyassociatedindirectoverheadcosts.This billwouldremoveSCHEVfromperformanceof theseduties.VRSmanagesthefundinvestments.Generally,theamountavailableforaward iscurrentlydependentuponvolatilemarketconditionsandtherevisedformulawouldprovide forbetterplanningandless fluctuationinfundsavailableforaward.

Other comments: State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) provides staff support (not paid by the fund) to the Board and the Virginia Retirement System (VRS) provides investment management services (paid by the fund) to the Board. Currently, t Boardisnotallowedtohirestafforpayforexpensessuchasphones, rent, etc. TheBoardis currently required to have SCHEV provide administrative support services and would prefer

to conduct its own business. This bill would free SCHEV from some of the administrative burdens, such a shiring an administrator and managing the logistical operations, and allow the Board to conduct its own affairs. This bill is now identical to HB1286.
