**4. Title** Career and technical education; annual plans.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill modifies the existing requirement within the Standards of Quality for local school boards to develop plans for career and technical education to provide for the input of area business and industry representatives and local community colleges in the plan's development. In addition, the plan must be submitted to the Superintendent of Public Instruction and the Chancellor of the Virginia Community College System annually.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal implications:** School boards are currently required to develop and implement a plan for competency-based career and technical education programs. This proposal requires that the plan be developed with the input of area business and industry representatives and local community colleges. Since the plan is already required, there should be no additional fiscal impact for the school boards. Local community colleges should be able to supply representatives to help refine the plan from existing resources.
