**4. Title** Motor vehicle registration fees for emergency services

**5. Summary/Purpose:** As amended, this bill would increase the motor vehicle registration fee by two dollars per year, beginning July 1, 2002. This surcharge will be applied to each pickup or panel truck and each motor vehicle under subdivisions 1 through 12 of § 46.2 -694 of the Code. Funds collected from this additional fee will be paid into the general fund support public safety and emergency response programs.

**8. Fiscal implications:** This bill would require the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to collect an additional two -dollar surcharge on all motor vehicle registrations, per § 46.2 -694, effective July 1, 2002 (FY 2003.) This, in turn, would allow DMV to increase its annual collections by an estimated \$13.0 million in FY 2003 and \$13.3 million in FY 2004, which would be transferred to the general fund to support public safety and emergency response purposes. DMV estimates that it would incur minimal expenses for programming costs associated with the implementation of this legislation.
