5. **Summary/Purpose:**

Allows localities to assess each criminal, civil and traffic case a fee of up to ten dollars for courthouse security.

8. **Fiscal implications:** If all localities imposed this fee, it is projected that this legislation would result in increased revenues statewide of \$25,486,000. Of the \$25.5 million increased revenue, \$24.4 million would be generated in district courts and \$1.1 million would be generated in circuit courts. This fee is in addition to any other fees prescribed by law. The funds generated would be available to the locality and would not be placed in the general fund.
