Summary/Purpose:** Thisbillmandatesthecollection, dissemination and reporting of the number of licensed and staffed acute carepsychiatric and residential treatment beds for children and adolescent sunder the age of 18 in public and private facilities. The bill allows any hospital or facility that must report this datat or eport it directly to the nonprofitor ganization cited in \$32.1-276.4. The bill requires the nonprofitor ganization to establishate chnical advisory committee to determine the actual demand for these beds. The provisions of this bill and Chapter 7.2 (\$32.1-276.2 et seq.) of Title 32.1 expire on July 1, 2003.

Fiscalimplications:** Thislegislationrequiresthatdataonthenumberofanddemandfor licensedandstaffedacutecarepsychiatri candresidentialtreatmentbedsforchildrenand adolescentsundertheageof18bemadepublic.FortheDepartmentofMentalHealth,Mental RetardationandSubstanceAbuseServices(DMHMRSAS),reportingofthisdatawouldhave minimalimpact,withtheC ommonwealthCenterforChildrenandAdolescentsbeingthemain publicfacilityaffected.ItisalsolikelythatthosefacilitieslicensedbyDMHMRSASwillbe minimallyimpactedbythedatasubmittalrequirements.TheVirginiaDepartmentofHealth,the contractingagencyforthisdatacollection,reportsthatthisbillwillhavenofiscalimpactonthe agency.
