5.	Summary/Purpose: This bill would establish the Roanoke River Basin Bi - State Commission. The Commission is abi - state advisory body composed of 18 citizen members, with nine members representing Virginia and nine members representing North Carolina. Those appointed to serve a smembers of the Commission are to represent a variety of interest group including permitholders, for estry and agricultural organizations, local government of ficials, and soil and water conservation districts. Statelegislators from both states may be nonvoting ex-officionembers of the Commission. The Commission has nor egulatory authority. Its purpose sinclude: (i) providing guidance and making recommendation stolocal, state and federal legislative and administrative bodies on the use, stewardship, and enhancement of the water and other natural resources with the Basin ; (ii) providing a forum for discussion of issues affecting the Basin's water quality, water quantity, and natural resources; (iii) promoting communication, coordination, and education among stakeholders; and (iv) identifying Basin related problems and recommending solutions.

8.	<b>Fiscalimplications:</b> Section 62.1 - 69.40 of the proposed legislation states that "funding for the Commission shall be a shared responsibility of the state and planning district commissions." The Rappahannock River Basin Commission enabling legislation (§ 62.1 - 25) contains similar language concerning funding. While \$60,000 for the Rappahannock River Basin Commission was provided in 2000 - 2002 biennial budget through Department of Conservation and Recreation, the reisn of unding recommended for the Commission in the proposed 2002 - 2004 budget.
