4. Title: Establishthe RoanokeRiverBasinCommission

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill would establish the Roanoke River Basin Commission, which is composed of the representatives of planning district commissions located within the Basin, statelegislators, a member of Congress, and nonvoting x - officion on voting members representing the interests of North Carolina. The Commission is advisory and has no regulatory authority. Its purposes include: (i) providing guidance and making recommen - dation stolocal, state and federallegislative and administrative bodies on the use, steward ship, and enhancement of the water and other natural resources within the Basin; (ii) providing a forum for discussion of issues affecting the Basin's water quality, water quantity, and natural resources; (iii) promoting communication, coordination, and education among stakeholders; (iv) identifying Basin - related problems and recommending solutions; and (v) conducting joint meetings and communicating with North Carolinal egislative and administrative bodies.

ThisbillalsoincorporatestheestablishmentoftheRoanokeRiverBasinBi CommissionasproposedinSB553.Thi sCommissionbecomeseffectiveJanuary1,2003,or uponenactmentofsimilarlegislationbytheStateofNorthCarolina,whicheveroccurslast. TheRoanokeRiverBasinBi -StateCommissionisabi -stateadvisorybodycomposedof18 citizenmembers, withnin emembers representing Virginia and nine members representing NorthCarolina. Those appointed to serve a smembers of the Commission are to represent a varietyofinterestgroups, including permitholders, forestry and agricultural organizations, localgov ernmentofficials, and soil and water conservation districts. Statelegislators from bothstatesmaybenonvotingex -officiomembersoftheCommission.TheCommissionhas noregulatoryauthority. Its purposes include: (i) providing guidance and making recommendationstolocal, state and federal legislative and administrative bodies on the use, stewardship, and enhancement of the water and other natural resources with the Basin; (ii) providing a forum for discussion of issues affecting the Basin's water q uality, waterquantity, and natural resources; (iii) promoting communication, coordination, and education among stakeholders; and (iv) identifying Basin -related problems and recommending solutions.
