Summary/Purpose:ThisbillauthorizestheBoardof Educationtosubstituteindustry certification and statelicensure examinations for Standards of Learning assessments for the purpose of enhancing the quality of career and technical education and awarding verified units of creditforcareerandtechnical educationcourses, whereappropriate. This bill also amends Standard 3 of the Standard sof Quality to allow the Board to provide, in the requirements for the account of the standard soft of theverifiedunitsofcreditstipulatedforobtainingthestandardoradvancedstudiesdiploma,that appropriateandrelevantindustrycertificationorstatelicensureexaminationsmaybesubstituted for correlated Standards of Learning examinations and that students completing career and the completing career and caretechnicaleducationprogramsthataredesignedtoenablesuchstude ntstopasssuchindustry certificationexaminationsorstatelicensureexaminationsmaybeawarded,uponobtaining satisfactoryscoresonsuchindustrycertificationorlicensureexaminations, appropriate verified unitsofcreditforoneormorecareeran dtechnicaleducationclassesintowhichrelevant StandardsofLearningforvarious classes taught at the same level have been integrated. Such industrycertificationandstatelicensureexaminationsmaycoverrelevantstandardsoflearning forvariousreq uiredclassesandmay, at the discretion of the Board, address various standards of learningforseveralrequiredcourses.
