Fiscalimplications: Thisbill, as a recommendation of HJR 614, was prompted because of the number of consumers with mental illness or mental retardation who are unable to make decisions for themselves and who have noguardian or substituted ecision - maker. Often these consumers need medical or dental care that may not be an emergency but which significantly affects their health and safety. This bill would likely make iteasier to obtain needed medical and dentals ervices before they become medical emergencies and requiremore costly treatment.
