## 5. Summary/Purpose:

Requires the court to make a finding concerning whether reasonable efforts have been made to place the child in a timely manner in accordance with the foster care plan and to take the steps necessary to finalize the permanent placement of the child at the actual hearing at which the court or ders the child 's permanent placement and annually thereafter. The bill requires an annual foster care review hearing for child renin permanent foster care. Permanent foster care is given a high er priority than independent living, to promote attachment to an adult car egiver. The Committee on District Courts has endorsed this bill.

ThislegislationwillensurethatVirginiameetsfederalrequirementsforfostercare.Failuretomeetthesefederalrequirementsbyenactmentofthislegislationwillresultinalossofapproximately \$11,000,000eachyear.ManyofthesecostswillbeshiftedtotheCommonwealthandlocalitiesunderthemorecostlyComprehensiveServicesAct.Finally,anindeterminableamountofpenaltiesmaybeleviedinadditiontotheamountlistedabove.Withoutthisstatutoryamendmenttomandateannualcourthearings,theDepartment'seffortstoexpandandmaximizeuseoffederalTitleIV-Efundingtocovercostsofchildreninfostercarewouldbediminished..

Whenevertheworkloadofjudgesandcler ksisincreased, the efficiency of the court system maybe impacted. The total possible impact on the court system as a result of the requirement for conducting an annual foster care review for children in permanent foster care is estimated to be \$167,680 each year. If the workload of the court sincreases beyond available resources, additional dollars may need to be appropriated.
