5. Summary/Purpose:

Thisbillclarifieslanguageadoptedl astyearregardingtheVirginiaLawOfficers'Retirement System(VaLORS). The bill amends the Codeso an individual must be vested (five years of service)inVaLORSinordertoreceivethehighermultiplierof2.0% when retiring. This change willensuret hatretiredlawenforcementofficerscannotretireandchoosetoreturntoservice under VaLORS and retire immediately with the higher multiplier. The individual must have five years of service under VaLORS to receive the higher multiplier. The bill also amendstheCode torequirefiveyearscreditableserviceundertheStatePoliceOfficers'Retirement(SPORS)or thespecialbenefitsforlawenforcementofficersorfirefighters(LEOS/FIRE)inordertobe eligibletoretireforserviceretirementwiththe enhancedbenefitspayableundertheSPORS section.Finally,thebillamendtheCodetohavetheLEO/FIRE(locallawenforcement officers/firefighters)deathinservicebenefitsmatchthoseprovidedunderVaLORSandSPORS (StatePoliceOfficers'Retiremen tSystem).BothVaLORSandSPORSassumethatthemember isage50ifthememberisundertheageof50atthetimeofdeath.Currently,LEO/FIRE provisions assume that the member is a ge 55 if death occurs prior to a ge 55.
