Thebillalsoamends theCode torequirefiveyearscreditableserviceundertheStatePoliceOfficers'Retirement(SPORS)or thespecialbenefitsforlawenforcementofficersorfirefighters(LEOS/FIRE)inordertobe eligibletoretireforserviceretirementwiththeenhanc edbenefitspayableundertheSPORS section. Finally, thebillamendtheCodetohavetheLEO/FIRE(locallawenforcement officers/firefighters)deathinservicebenefitsmatchthoseprovidedunderVaLORSandSPORS (StatePoliceOfficers'RetirementSyste m).
