	Aswritten,theproposedlegislationrequiresthecommunitycollegestodeterminethe incrementalcostofeachnoncreditcourse,andtooffernoncreditcour sesforexactlythis incrementalcost. Currently, noncreditcourses at the community colleges must cover their costs, and usually provide additional revenue to the colleges over and above their direct costs. The procedures for determination of incrementa lost are to be promulgated by the Auditor of Public Accounts. Without knowing the procedure seach college will have to follow, it is not possible to determine the fiscal impact of this provision. However, it will take significant amounts of administrative time to cost out each course exactly, and to adjust the fees for each and every course instead of using a standard fees chedule. Furthermore, the requirement to offer courses at the times and places that meet the needs of employers may be difficult for the colleges to meet.		rthe
