5. Summary/Purpose:

As amended by substitute, requires community colleges to (i) maximize noncredit course offerings made available to business and industry at a time and place that meets current and projected workforce needs and minimize the cost of noncredit offerings to business and industry to the extent feasible, and (ii) deal directly with employers in designing and offering courses to meet real, current and projected workforce training needs. A provision requiring the colleges to offer the courses at an incremental cost has been removed.
