4. Title Regulationofprivate&out -of-stateinstitutionsofhighereduca tion

## 5. Summary/Purpose:

RegulationofCertainPrivateandout -of-stateInstitutionsofHigherEducationclarifiesand strengthensthepresentregulatoryschemeforapprovalofprivateandout -of-stateinstitutions tooperateandgrantdegreesinVirginia.Thisbill(i)de fineskeytermsrelatingtothis approvalprocess;(ii)setsoutexemptionsforsuchactivitiesasgrantinghonorarvdegreesand certainprofessionaltrainingprogramsthataresubjecttoregulatoryboards, postsecondary institutionsregulatedbytheDepar tmentofEducationthatoffernondegreeprograms, other noncreditprograms,contractprograms,etc.;(iii)establishestheStateCouncilofHigher Education for Virginia's authority to adopt regulations for procedures, minimal academic standards, protectio nsforstudents, and information to assist third parties who rely on postsecondarycredentials;(iv)mandatesthatapprovalbeobtainedfromtheCouncilpriorto usingtheterm"college"or"university,"enrollingstudents,offeringdegrees,etc.;(v) grandfatherscertaininstitutionsthatwereinexistencepriortoJuly1,1980;(vi)clarifiesthe division of authority between the State Council and the Department of Education, i.e., that anyinstitutionthatisapprovedtograntdegrees, does not offernon -degreecreditprograms butdoesoffercertificateanddiplomaprogramsfordegreecreditwillonlybesubjecttothe authorityoftheCouncil;and(vii)clearlynotestheCouncil'sauthoritytograntprovisional approvalortomodifyapreviousapproval, torefuse, revokeors uspendits approval under certaincircumstances, and to issue emergency actions; (viii) student records are protected through requirements for maintenance and orderly transfer in the event of a closure. Fees maybecharged.Violati onsoftheseprovisionswillbepunishableasaClass1misdemeanor. Further, the Council may institute a proceeding in equity to enjoin any violation of a provisionand will be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and cost supon substantially prevailing on the merits unless special circumstances would render such an award unjust. The oldchaptergoverningprivateandout -of-stateinstitutionsisrepealed;theCouncil'spresent regulations are continued until new regulations are inplace, and the Council isrequiredto promulgateemergencyregulations.

ThereisnofiscalimplicationfortheSt ateCouncilofHigherEducationforVirginia.There couldbeafuturefiscalimpactforthoseinstitutionscoveredbythisprovisionshouldfeesbe assessedforfutureservices.However,atthispointafeeschedulehasnotbeenproposedand planistos tudythemattermorefullyduringtheAPAregulationrevisionprocess.
