5. Summary/Purpose: The bill authorizes the issuance of Commonwealth of Virginia Parkand Recreational Facilities Bondspursuant to Article X, Section 9(b) of the Constitution of Virginia in an amount not exceeding \$119,040,000, subject to approval by amajority of the qualified voters of the Commonweal th voting the reonatthe November 5,2002, general election. The purpose of the bonds is to provide funds for (i) acquiring land and developing state parks; (ii) acquiring land for natural area preservation; and (iii) construct ion of numerous specified projects at existing state parks. The full faith and credit of the Commonweal this pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds and any bond anticipation notes or refunding bonds.

Thisbillalsocontains as a precondition for authorization that the Governor prepare and release aplan, to the chairmen of the Senate Finance and House Appropriations Committees by December 1,2002, for the orderly is suance of the bonds. The planis required to include the development of processes to expedite the capital outlay review process and the development of detailed drawschedules, to the extent practicable, and an estimate of net additional costs of staffing and equipping such projects.

The bill contains a seconden a ctment clause that requires the Secretary of Finance to provide to the chairmen of the Senate Finance and House Appropriations committees, by April 1 and September 1 of each year, a status report on the projects, including compliance with the preconditions as set out for the initial authorization of the projects.

Fiscalimplications: Thedebtserviceimpactiscomputedbasedonpreliminarydraw scheduleswiththeassumptionoffivetax -exemptbondissues:\$6.1millioninFY2003,\$15.8 millioninFY2004,\$32.0millioninFY20 05,\$30.2millioninFY2006,and\$34.9millionin FY2007.Thisdoesnotfactorintheuseoftax -exemptcommercialpapertoprovideinterim fundingfortheseprojects.Onceallbondsareissued,annualdebtservicewouldpeakat approximately\$12.5mil lionin2008 anddeclinethereafter .Theissuanceofthebondswillbe structuredsothatdebtservicepaymentswouldnotbeginuntil December2003,whichisinFY 2004.

ThefiscalimpactontheDepartmentofConservationandRecreation(DCR)wouldaf fectboth expendituresandrevenues.Someoftheprojectsproposedinthebillwouldgenerate additionalrevenuesforthestateparksystem.However,thedepartmentwouldrequire additionalfundstooperateandmaintainthemajorityofthenewfacilities onceacquisition and/orconstructioniscompleted.Thesecostswouldlikelybeoutsidethe2002 -2004 biennium.ThedepartmentwouldalsorequireadditionalpositionsbeginninginFY2004to overseethedesignandconstructionoftheseprojects.Restric tedpositionswhosepayrollcosts arechargeddirectlytotherelatedbondprojectsmaybeutilized.
