The Department of the Treasury has advised the Department of Planning and Budgetthat capital projects for "planning only" cannot be financed using tax-exempt bonds. House Bill 1284 includes one such project, Norfolk State University's Renovate Robinson Tech Building, \$598,000. In addition, the Capitol Square Renovations, Phase I project include sup to \$3.0 million in plannin g, or 60 percent of the total project, for renovation sto the State Capitol. However, the \$3.0 million can be used for renovation sto facilities at the seat of government.
