Summary/Purpose: Thislegislationproposestorequireeachapplicantformitial registration, licensure, or certification as a compliance agent, private security services training school, or instructor or unarmed security officer to submithis finger prints for the conductofa criminalrecordscheck. The bill also requires an unarmed security officer applying for renewalbetweenJanuary1,2003andDecember31,2004tosubmithisfingerprintsforthe purposeofacriminal recordscheck. The bill also authorizes the D epartmenttosuspenda registration, license, or certification based on the conviction of certain misdemean or sorany felonyandprovidesthatmakingafalsestatementonthefingerprintcardshallbeaClass5 felony.Inaddition.thebillestablishesco mpulsoryminimumstandardsforarmoredcar personnelandexemptsfromtherequirementforlicensure, registration, or certification personsengagedinthebusinessofaconsumer -reportingagencyasdefinedbytheFederalFair CreditReportingAct.

8. Fiscalimplications: Thefiscalimpactofthislegislationisuncertain. TheDepartmentof CriminalJusticeServices(DCJS)advisesthattheinclusionofunarmedsecurityofficersw increasethenumberoffingerprintcardscomingintotheagencybyapproximately9,000each year. Theagencyalsoadvisesthatitonlyreceivesapproximately\$40fthe\$41feechargedto processthesefingerprintsastheremaining\$37goestothegene ralfundviatheVirginia DepartmentofStatePolice(DSP).DCJSadvisesthatitsprocessingcostsexceedthe\$4they collect.

## Revised

TheDepartmentofStatePoliceadvisesthatitestimatesapproximately8,500newfingerprint cardswouldneedtobeprocessed tomeetthisnewrequirement.

Related to the proposed Class 5 felony penalty for will fulviolation of this proposed provision, there is no expected be dimpact on the state's adult or juve nile correctional systems from the proposed legislation.

TheGen eralAssemblydidnotprovideanyfundingorpositionsforthisbill.ThePrivate SecurityServicesSectionofDCJSispresentlynotgeneratingsufficientrevenuetofullycover itsoperatingexpenses.Thisproposedlegislationcouldexacerbatethisprob lem,as expendituresareexpectedtobehigherthantherevenuegeneratedbythisaction.
