10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-204.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12 13	§ 18.2-204.1. Fraudulent use of birth certificates, drivers' licenses, etc.
13	A. It shall be unlawful for any person to obtain or, possess, <i>sell</i> , or transfer the birth certificate of another for the purpose of establishing a false identity for himself or for another person.
15	B. It shall be unlawful for any person to <i>obtain</i> , possess, sell, or transfer any document for the
16	purpose of establishing a false status, occupation, membership, license or identity for himself or any
17	other person.
18	C. Any person who shall violate violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a Class 1
19	misdemeanor, except when the birth certificate or document is obtained, possessed, sold, or transferred
20 21	with the intent to use such certificate or document to purchase a firearm, in which case a violation of this section shall be punishable as a Class 6 felony.
22	D. The provisions of this section shall not apply to members of state, federal, county, city or town
23	law-enforcement agencies in the performance of their duties.
