4 5 6 7 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 46.2-749.23:1 and by adding in 8 Article 10 of Chapter 6 of Title 46.2 sections numbered 46.2-749.84 through 456.2-749.88, relating 9 to special license plates; Virginia is for Lovers; supporters of the National D-Day Memorial 10 Foundation; commemorating the thirtieth anniversary of Secretariat's winning of horse racing's Triple Crown; supporters of Seton House; supporters of the Interdenominational Children's Foundation of Virginia; supporters of the Cold War Museum; fees. 11 12 13

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-749.23:1 and by 14 15 adding in Article 10 of Chapter 6 of Title 46.2 sections numbered 46.2-749.84 through 46.2-749.88 16 as follows: 17

§ 46.2-749.23:1. Special license plates: Virginia is for lovers; fees.

A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 18 shall issue to the applicant special license plates bearing the legend: VIRGINIA IS FOR LOVERS. 19

20 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed 21 fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to 22 this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known 23 as the Virginia Tourism Promotion Fund established within the Department of Accounts and paid 24 annually in equal amounts to the Virginia Tourism Authority and the Virginia Hospitality and Travel 25 Association Foundation to be spent to support tourism promotion activities for the benefit of Virginians. 26 § 46.2-749.84. Special license plates; supporters of the National D-Day Memorial Foundation; fees.

A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to supporters of the National D-Day Memorial Foundation.

29 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed 30 fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to 31 this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known 32 as the National D-Day Memorial Foundation Fund, established within the Department of Accounts. 33 These funds shall be paid annually to the National D-Day Memorial Foundation and used to assist in 34 its programs, activities, and operation. 35

§ 46.2-749.85. Special license plates commemorating the thirtieth anniversary of Secretariat's winning of horse racing's Triple Crown; fees.

A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 37 38 shall issue to the applicant special license plates commemorating the thirtieth anniversary of 39 Secretariat's winning of horse racing's Triple Crown.

40 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed 41 fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known 42 as the Secretariat Museum Foundation Fund, established within the Department of Accounts. These 43 44 funds shall be paid annually to the Secretariat Museum Foundation and used to assist in the creation 45 and operation of the Secretariat Museum. 46

§ 46.2-749.86. Special license plates; supporters of Seton House; fees.

47 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates to supporters of Seton House. **48**

49 B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to 50 this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known 51 as the Seton House Fund, established within the Department of Accounts. These funds shall be paid 52 53 annually to Seton House and used to support its programs and activities in Virginia. 54

§ 46.2-749.87. Special license plates; Interdenominational Children's Foundation of Virginia; fees.

55 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates for supporters of the Interdenominational Children's 56 Foundation of Virginia. 57

B. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed 58 59 fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to

60 this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known

61 as the Interdenominational Children's Foundation of Virginia Fund, established within the Department 62 of Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the Interdenominational Children's Foundation of

63 Virginia and used to support the Foundation's activities and programs.

64 § 446.2-749.88. Special license plates; supporters of the Cold War Museum; fees.

65 A. On receipt of an application and payment of the fee prescribed by this section, the Commissioner 66 shall issue special license plates to supporters of the Cold War Museum.

67 B. The annual fee for the plates issued pursuant to this section shall be \$25 in addition to the 68 prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations

69 persuant to this section, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting

70 fund known as the Cold War Museum Fund, established within the Department of Accounts. These funds

shall be paid annually to the Cold War Museum and used to assist in its programs and activities in
Virginia.
