That §§ 33.1-124 and 33.1-128 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 33.1-124. Proceedings for distribution of funds; effect of acceptance of payments; evidence as to 12 13 amount of deposit or certificate. 14 Any person or persons shown by such certificate to be entitled thereto may petition the court for the 15 distribution of all or any part of the funds deposited with the court pursuant to § 33.1-120 or represented 16 by a certificate recorded pursuant to § 33.1-121. A copy of such petition shall be served on the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner, his deputy or any attorney authorized to accept service 17 18 with a notice returnable to the court or judge not less than twenty-one days after such service, to show cause, if any, the Commissioner can, why such amount should not be distributed in accordance with the 19 20 prayers of the petition. If the Commissioner does not, on or before the return day of the petition, show 21 such cause, and if the record in the proceeding does not disclose any denial or dispute with respect 22 thereto, the court shall enter an order directing the distribution of such amount in accordance with the 23 prayers of the petition. However, in the case of a nonresident petitioner the court may in its discretion 24 require a bond before ordering the distribution. If funds have been deposited with the court pursuant to 25 § 33.1-120, any interest which has accrued on the funds shall be payable to the person or persons entitled to receive such funds. If funds are not then on deposit with the court but are represented by a 26 27 certificate pursuant to § 33.1-121, a certified copy of such order shall forthwith be sent to the 28 Commissioner by the clerk. It shall be the duty of the Commissioner to deposit such funds with the 29 court within twenty-one days of the date of such order. Interest at the general account composite rate as 30 set forth in § 33.1-128 one year Treasury Constant Maturity Rate as published by the Board of 31 Governors of the Federal Reserve System shall be payable on such funds from the date of filing of such certificate if the funds are not deposited with the clerk when the certificate is filed. However, no interest 32 33 shall accrue if an injunction is filed against the Department of Transportation for the taking. 34 If the Commissioner shows such cause, or if the record in the proceeding discloses any denial or 35 dispute as to the persons entitled to such distribution or to any interest or share therein, the court shall 36 direct such proceedings as are provided by § 25-46.28 for the distribution of awards. 37 However, the acceptance of such payment shall not limit the amount to be allowed by a 38 commissioner in a condemnation proceeding, nor limit the rights of any party or parties to the 39 proceeding to appeal from any decision therein; nor shall any party to such proceeding be entitled to 40 introduce evidence of any amount deposited with the court or represented by a certificate, nor of any 41 amount which has been accepted by any party entitled thereto pursuant to this section. § 33.1-128. Awards in greater or lesser amounts than deposit; interest. 42 43 In the event of an award in a condemnation proceeding being of a greater amount than that deposited 44 by virtue of a certificate, the excess amount, together with interest accrued on such excess amount at the general account composite rate, compiled by the Department of the Treasury of Virginia one year 45 Treasury Constant Maturity Rate as published by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System 46 47 for the month in which the award is rendered, computed from the date of such deposit to the date of payment into court, shall be paid into court for the person or persons entitled thereto, except that any 48 49 interest which accrued before July 1, 1970, shall be paid at the rate of five percent, and interest accruing thereafter and prior to July 1, 1981, shall be paid at the rate of six percent, and any interest accruing 50 51 thereafter and prior to July 1, 1994, shall be paid at the rate of eight percent, and any interest accruing 52 thereafter and prior to July 1, 2003, shall be paid at the general account composite rate, compiled by 53 the Department of the Treasury for the month in which the award is rendered. In the event of an award

in a condemnation proceeding being of a lesser amount than that deposited with the court, and the 54 55 person or persons entitled thereto have received the funds deposited with the court pursuant to § 33.1-124, the Commissioner shall recover the amount of such excess and interest on such excess at the 56 general account composite rate one year Treasury Constant Maturity Rate as published by the Board of 57 58 Governors of the Federal Reserve System and, if any person has been paid a greater sum than that to

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- which he is entitled as determined by the award, judgment shall be entered for the Commissioner against such person for the amount of such excess and interest. 59
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
