035124796 1 **HOUSE BILL NO. 2196** 2 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE 34 56 7 (Proposed by the House Committee on Privileges and Elections on January 31, 2003) (Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate Jones, S. C.) A BILL to amend and reenact § 24.2-923 of the Code of Virginia, relating to campaign finance disclosure reports; filing schedule for persons and political committees. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 8 9 1. That § 24.2-923 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 24.2-923. Filing schedule for persons and political committees. A. Persons and political committees shall file the prescribed reports of contributions and expenditures 11 with the State Board in accordance with the applicable schedule set out in subsection C and in 12 <u>\$\$ 24.2-918 and 24.2-919</u>. The first filed report shall be complete for the entire period from the time the 13 committee was organized or contributions were received. Each political party committee for a county, 14 city, or local district which that is required to file the prescribed reports shall also file the report with the 15 16 local electoral board for its jurisdiction. B. The reporting requirements shall continue in effect for each committee until a final report is filed 17 which that sets forth (i) all receipts and disbursements not previously reported, (ii) an accounting of the 18 retirement of all debts, and (iii) the disposition of all residual funds. The final report shall include a 19 20 termination statement, signed by an officer of the committee, that all reporting is complete and final. 21 C. Persons and political committees shall file the prescribed reports of contributions and expenditures 22 as follows: 23 1. Eight days before the first Tuesday in March complete through the eleventh day before that 24 **Tuesday:** 25 2. Eight days before the first Tuesday in May complete through the eleventh day before that 26 Tuesday; 27 3. Eight days before the first Tuesday in June complete through the thirteenth day before that 28 Tuesday: 29 4. Eight days before the Tuesday after the first Monday in November complete through the thirteenth 30 day before that Tuesday: 31 5. Not later than the thirtieth day after the November election date complete through the twenty-third 32 day after the election date; and 33 6. Not later than July 15 complete from the preceding report through June 30; and 34 2. Not later than January 15 complete from the preceding report through December 31, and then 35 continuing in accordance with this subsection until a final report is filed. 36 In addition to the semi-annual reports required by this subsection, persons and political committees 37 shall file a pre-election report not later than the eighth day before the election date complete from the 38 preceding report through the thirteenth day before the election date (i) if previously unreported 39 expenditures relating to a primary, special or general election totaling \$500 or more have been made to 40 or on behalf of a single candidate for local office, \$1,000 or more have been made to or on behalf of a single candidate for the General Assembly, or \$5,000 or more have been made to or on behalf of a 41 42 single candidate for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Attorney General, or (ii) if previously unreported expenditures relating to a primary, special or general election totaling \$1,000 or more have 43 been made to or on behalf of candidates for local office in a single locality, totaling \$2,500 or more 44 have been made to or on behalf of candidates for the General Assembly, or \$7,500 or more have been 45 made to or on behalf of candidates for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and Attorney General. 46 D. Persons and political committees shall also file reports in accordance with the schedule for a general, special, or primary election set out in § 24.2-919 for certain large pre-election contributions 47 **48** 49 only for the general, special, or primary election to which the contribution pertains. E. The State Board shall provide for a "no activity" report that may be filed for any period set out in 50 51 subsection C in which the filer has no activity to report.

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
