| 10 11 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 2.2 a section |
| 12 | numbered 2.2-214.1 as follows: |
| 13 | § 2.2-214.1. Healthy Lives Prescription Fund; nonreverting; purposes; report. |
| 14 | A. There is hereby created in the Department of the Treasury a special nonreverting fund that shall |
| 15 | be known as the Healthy Lives Prescription Fund. |
| 16 | B. The fund shall be established on the books of the Comptroller. The Fund shall consist of such |
| 17 | moneys appropriated by the General Assembly and any funds available from the federal government, |
| 18 | donations, grants, and in-kind contributions made to the Fund for the purposes stated herein. Interest |
| 19 | earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in |
| 20 | the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund |
| 21 | but shall remain in the Fund. |
| 22 | C. Moneys in the Fund shall be available to develop and implement programs that will enhance |
| 23 | current prescription drug programs for citizens of the Commonwealth who are without insurance or |
| 24 | ability to pay for prescription drugs and to develop innovative programs to make such prescription |
| 25 | drugs more available. |

26 D. The Secretary shall provide an annual report on the status of the Fund and efforts to meet the
27 goals of the Fund.
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
