9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 32.1-229.01 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 32.1-229.01. Companies listed as proficient to perform radon screening, testing or mitigation;
12	compliance.
13	A. No person shall conduct or offer to conduct any radon screening, testing or mitigation in the
14	Commonwealth unless he has been listed as proficient by the United States Environmental Protection
15	Agency, the National Radon Measurement Proficiency Program of the National Environmental Health
16	Association or the National Radon Safety Board Certified Radon Professional Program or any other
17	proficiency program acceptable to the Board of Health to offer such screening, testing or mitigation.
18	For the purposes of this article, "person" shall be defined as provided in § 1-13.19.
19	B. Radon professionals listed as proficient pursuant to subsection A shall comply with the radon
20	mitigation and testing standards outlined in EPA 402-R-93-078, as revised, or [ASTMI ASTM

21 International] Standard Practice [$E \frac{2121-01}{21}E 2121-02$], or any other radon testing and mitigation **22** standards accepted by the Environmental Protection Agency and the Board.
