11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 54.1-2957.6 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 54.1-2957.6. Exceptions to athletic trainer certification.
14 15	A. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to prohibit any individual from providing
15 16	first aid, nor any coach, physical education instructor or other person from (i) conducting or assisting with exercise or conditioning programs or classes within the scope of their duties as employees or
17	volunteers or (ii) applying protective taping to an uninjured body part.
18	B. The requirements for certification of athletic trainers shall not prevent student athletic trainers
19	from practicing athletic training under the supervision and control of a certified athletic trainer pursuant
20	to regulations promulgated by the Board.
21	C. Notwithstanding the provisions of §§ 54.1-2957.4 and 54.1-2957.5, any person who, prior to June
22	30, 1999, is employed in Virginia as an athletic trainer, or in the performance of his employment duties
	is a superproduction of the performance of the employment during
