8 national president of the Grand Lodge Fraternal Order of Police Associates; and

10 Order of Police, and its members are the friends and families of law-enforcement officers, business
11 people, professionals, and citizens from all walks of life who support law-enforcement agencies on the
12 local, state, and national levels; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the FOPA include increasing understanding of the rights, duties, and
 problems of law-enforcement officers, fostering respect for them, and bettering the conditions under
 which they serve society; and

WHEREAS, Eileen Buckley began her association with the Fraternal Order of Police as an associate member of Jerald F. Young Lodge DC1 in 1972; and

18 WHEREAS, a member of NOVA Lodge 35 since 1991, Eileen Buckley has served the lodge as19 trustee, vice president, and president; and

20 WHEREAS, on the state level, Eileen Buckley has served the Virginia FOPA as sergeant at arms and 21 as president; and

WHEREAS, Eileen Buckley has also served as secretary of the Northern Virginia Chapter Board of Easter Seals and is a lifetime member of the Washington Area Police Emerald Society, which selected her as Member of the Year in 1988; now, therefore, be it
