7	WHEREAS, Vincent J. Olson, a revered and respected statesman and town council member, is
8	retiring in 2003 after 26 years of exemplary service to the Town of Vienna; and
9	WHEREAS, prior to serving on the Vienna Town Council, Vincent Olson was a member of the town
10	planning commission; and
11	WHEREAS, Vincent Olson first was elected to the Vienna Town Council in 1976 and served the
12	citizenry with compassion and dedication until retiring for the first time in 1988; and
13 14	WHEREAS, called back into service the next year, Vincent Olson was appointed to serve out the
14	remainder of Richard Fisher's term in 1989 and, subsequently, was elected in his own right to successive two-year terms, continuing to serve on the Vienna Town Council until the present ; and
16	WHEREAS, considered invaluable in the budget process by the mayor and fellow council members,
17	Vincent Olson was committed to fiscal responsibility in local government; and
18	WHEREAS, Vincent Olson served as chairman of the charter review committee in 1980, council
19	representative for the Highway Safety Commission in 1976, member of the Vienna Municipal League
20	transportation committee in 1977 through 1987, and liaison to the County Board of Supervisors and
21	School Board; and
22	WHEREAS, Vincent Olson served as mayor pro tem in 1980 and 1997; and
23	WHEREAS, Vincent Olson was instrumental in the creation of an off-leash dog park and other
24	improvements that enhanced the enjoyment of town life; and
25	WHEREAS, Vincent Olson retired in 1999 as a distributor of the Washington Post; and
26	WHEREAS, an avid community supporter, Vincent Olson is an active member of the Vienna Ayr
27	Hill Lions Club; and
28	WHEREAS, devoted to the Town of Vienna, Vincent Olson was committed to improving the quality
29	of life for its residents; now, therefore, be it
30	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly

commend Vincent J. Olson, an excellent public servant and outstanding Virginian; and, be it RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Vincent J.
