That § 46.2-2099.41 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 7 § 46.2-2099.41. Certification requirements. 8 A. A person may apply to the Department for certification as an operator of an excursion train. The 9 Department shall certify an applicant if the Department determines that the applicant will operate a 10 passenger train that: 1. Is primarily used for tourism or public service; 11 12 2. Leads to the promotion of the tourist industry in the Commonwealth; and 13 3. Is primarily operated within a county having a population between 50,000 and 55,000 people, or a county having a population between 26,000 and 27,000. 14 15 B. An application for certification shall include: 1. The name and address of each person who owns an interest of at least ten 10 percent of the 16 17 excursion train operation; 18 2. An address in this Commonwealth where the excursion train is based; 19 3. An operations plan including the route to be used and a schedule of operations and stops along the 20 route; and 21 4. Evidence of insurance that meets the requirements of subsection C of this section. 22 C. The Department shall not certify to a person under subsection A unless the person files with the 23 Department evidence of insurance providing coverage of liability resulting from injury to persons or damages to property in the amount of at least ten \$10 million dollars for the operation of the train. 24 25 D. The Department shall not certify an applicant under subsection A of this section if the applicant 26 or any other person owning interest in the excursion train also owns or operates a regularly scheduled

27 passenger train service with interstate connection.
