6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Title 33.1 a chapter numbered 10.2, consisting of
7	sections numbered 33.1-391.6 through 33.1-391.9, relating to the Rail Transportation Development
8 9	Authority. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 33.1 a chapter numbered 10.2,
11	consisting of sections numbered 33.1-391.6 through 33.1-391.9, as follows:
12	CHAPTER 10.2.
13	RAIL TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.
14	§ 33.1-391.6. Short title.
15	This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the Rail Transportation Development Authority Act.
16	§ 33.1-391.7. Authority created; purpose.
17	There is hereby created the Rail Transportation Development Authority, hereinafter known as the
18 19	Authority. The purpose of the Authority shall be to finance or assist in the financing of capital
20	improvements to freight and passenger rail lines and associated facilities. § 33.1-391.8. Composition of Authority; Chairman and Vice-Chairman; quorum.
2 0 2 1	The Authority shall consist of 11 voting members appointed by the Governor, with 1 member from
$\overline{22}$	each congressional district. All members shall serve for terms of 4 years and may be reappointed for 1
23	additional term. For the initial appointments, 3 appointments shall be for terms of 1 year, 3
24	appointments shall be for terms of 2 years, 3 shall be for terms of 3 years, and 2 appointments shall be
25	for a term of 4 years. Any initial terms of less than 4 years shall not count against the term limitation.
26	Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term.
27	The Authority shall elect from its membership a chairman and vice-chairman, who shall continue to
28 29	hold such office until their respective successors are elected. Six members of the authority shall constitute a quorum.
30	§ 33.1-391.9. Powers of Authority.
31	The Authority shall have the following powers together with all powers incidental thereto or
32	necessary for the performance of those hereinafter stated:
33	1. To sue and be sued and to prosecute and defend, at law or in equity, in any court having
34	jurisdiction of the subject matter and of the parties;
35	2. To adopt and use a corporate seal and to alter the same at pleasure;
36 37	3. To contract and be contracted with; 4. To establish bylaws and make all rules and regulations, not inconsistent with the provisions of this
37 38	chapter, deemed expedient for the management of the Authority's affairs;
39	5. To borrow money and to accept contributions, grants, and other financial assistance from the
40	United States of America and agencies or instrumentalities thereof, the Commonwealth or any political
41	subdivision, public instrumentality or agency thereof;
42	6. To issue bonds in accordance with applicable law, including the issuance of bonds and other
43	evidences of debt, in order to finance or assist in the financing of rail transportation projects
44 45	undertaken under the Public-Private Transportation Act of 1995 (§ 56-556 et seq.) and other laws for
45 46	the purpose of capital improvements to rail lines and associated facilities; and 7. To receive and expend moneys on behalf of the Authority.
47	2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on July 1, 2004.
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
