7 8	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-479.1 as follows: § 18.2-479.1. Resisting lawful arrest; penalty.	
9	A. Any person who intentionally prevents or attempts to prevent a law-enforcement officer from	
10	lawfully arresting him, with or without a warrant, is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.	
11	B. For purposes of this section, intentionally preventing or attempting to prevent a lawful arrest	
12	means fleeing from a law-enforcement officer when (i) the officer applies physical force to the person,	
13	or (ii) the officer communicates to the person that he is under arrest and (a) the officer has the legal	
14	authority and the immediate physical ability to place the person under arrest, and (b) a reasonable	
15	person who receives such communication knows or should know that he is not free to leave.
