14 satisfaction, quitclaim deeds, homestead deeds, grants, transfers and mortgages of	
15 such mortgages, powers of attorney to convey real estate, leases of real estate, not	
16 all contracts in reference to real estate, which have been acknowledged as require	
17 copies of final judgments or decrees of partition affecting the title or possession	
18 of which is situated in the county or city in which it is sought to be recorded,	
19 relating to or affecting real estate which are authorized to be recorded, shall, unle	
20 be recorded in a book to be known as the deed book. All deeds, deeds of t
