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12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
13	1. That §§ 29.1-101 and 29.1-103 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted, and that the
14 15	Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 3 of Chapter 1 of Title 29.1 a section numbered 29.1-113 as follows:
13 16	§ 29.1-101. Game Protection Fund.
17	The amount received by the State Treasurer from the collection of admittance, parking, or other use
18	fees, the sale of hunting, trapping and fishing licenses, revenue generated from the sales and use tax
19	pursuant to subsection E of § 58.1-638, and such other items as may accrue to the Board shall be set
20	aside and shall constitute the Game Protection Fund. The income and principal of this Fund, including
21 22	any unexpended balance, shall be a separate fund in the state treasury and shall only be used for the payment of the salaries, allowances, wages, and expenses incident to carrying out the provisions of the
$\frac{22}{23}$	hunting, trapping and inland fish laws and for no other purpose, except as provided in §§ 29.1-101.01,
24	29.1-701, 58.1-345 and 58.1-1410.
25	§ 29.1-103. Powers and duties of the Board.
26	The Board is responsible for carrying out the purposes and provisions of this title and is authorized
27 28	to: 1 Appoint the Director of the Department
20 29	 Appoint the Director of the Department. Acquire by purchase, lease, exchange, gift or otherwise, lands and waters in the Commonwealth
30	and to establish buildings, structures, dams, lakes and ponds on such lands and waters.
31	3. Conduct operations for the preservation and propagation of game birds, game animals, fish and
32	other wildlife in order to increase, replenish and restock the lands and inland waters of the
33	Commonwealth.
34 35	4. Purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire lands and waters for game and fish refuges, preserves or public shooting and fishing, and establish such lands and waters under appropriate regulations.
36	5. Acquire by purchase, lease, or otherwise, lands and structures for use as public landings, wharves,
37	or docks; to improve such lands and structures; and to control the use of all such public landings,
38	wharves, or docks by regulation.
39	6. Acquire and introduce any new species of game birds, game animals or fish on the lands and
40	within the waters of the Commonwealth.
41 42	7. Restock, replenish and increase any depleted native species of game birds, game animals, or fish. 8. Have educational matter pertaining to wildlife published and distributed.
43	9. Hold exhibits throughout the Commonwealth for the purpose of educating school children,
44	agriculturists and other persons in the preservation and propagation of wildlife in the Commonwealth.
45	10. Control land owned by and under control of the Commonwealth in Back Bay, its tributaries and
46	the North Landing River from the North Carolina line to North Landing Bridge. The Board shall
47 48	regulate or prohibit by regulation any drilling, dredging or other operation designed to recover or obtain shells, minerals, or other substances in order to prevent practices and operations which would harm the
40 49	area for fish and wildlife.
50	11. Exercise powers it may deem advisable for conserving, protecting, replenishing, propagating and
51	increasing the supply of game birds, game animals, fish and other wildlife of the Commonwealth.
52	12. Adopt resolutions or regulations conferring upon the Director all such powers, authorities and
53 54	duties as the Board possesses and deems necessary or proper to carry out the purposes of this title.
54 55	13. Administer and manage the Virginia Fish Passage Grant and Revolving Loan Fund pursuant to Article 1.1 (§ 29.1-101.2 et seq.) of Chapter 1 of this title.
56	14. Establish and collect admittance, parking, or other use fees at Department-owned facilities.
57	§ 29.1-113. Admittance, parking, and use at Department-owned facilities; civil penalty.
58	A. No person shall make use of, gain admittance to, or attempt to use or gain admittance to any

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Department-owned facility for the use of which a charge is assessed by the Department, unless the person pays the charge or price established by the Board. B. Any person violating this section may, in lieu of any criminal penalty, be assessed a civil penalty of \$50 by the Department. Civil penalties assessed under this section shall be paid into the Game 59 60
