13	An appeal shall lie from the final judgment of the circuit court in a bond validation proceeding may
14	be taken to the Supreme Court of Virginia from the final judgment of the court. No appeal shall be
15	allowed unless the petition for it a notice of appeal is filed in the circuit court within fifteen 15 days
16	after the date on which the <i>final</i> judgment of the court is entered and only if the party taking unless the
17	appealing party's petition for appeal has the record certified to is filed with the Supreme Court of
18	Virginia and the appealing party's brief is filed within thirty 30 days after the date on which the final
19 20	judgment of the court is entered. When a notice of appeal is timely and properly filed with the clerk of
20	the circuit court, the clerk shall certify and transmit the record to the Clerk of the Supreme Court of
21 22	Virginia within 30 days after the date on which the final judgment of the circuit court is entered. Failure of the clerk to comply with this requirement shall not affect the jurisdiction of the Supreme
