Assuminganactualprevailingsracticeofsixresourcetea chersper1,000elementarystudents andusingtheelementaryprevailingsalaryandbenefitsandFallMembershipdataforgrades K-5(ADMdataisnotbrokendownbygrade), theestimatedstateshareofthecostis\$78.9 millionforfiscalyear2003and\$80. 1millionforfiscalyear2004 .Thiscostwasderivedby dividingfallmembershipby1,000andmultiplyingthisfigurebythesixteacherstandard.
