Establishesareviewprocedurefornonstateagencyapplicationsrelatedtoarts,humanities and culturalinstitutions. The bill (Page 2, lines 70-72) appears to exclude capital expenditures and nonrecurring expenditures such as equipment. The recommendations of the two review groups are not binding on the Governor or the General Assembly. The bill also requires that applications for historic reservation, heretofore handled by the Department of Historic Resources, must now be submitted to the Department of Planning and Budget. The bill, if enacted, would not apply to nonstate agencies for which appropriations are added by legislative amendmen to the introduced Budget Bill.
