6.	Fiscalimpact: Thisbillwouldresultinacostsavingstotheextentthatsuchretroactive paymentswouldnolongerhavetobemade. Underthe Line of Duty Act, the surviving spouses and dependents of certain publics afety officers killed in the line of duty and certain publics afety officers disabled in the line of duty, and the spouses and dependents of such disabled officers, are provided health in surance coverage. Currently, the Act requir est hat payments for such health in surance coverage be retroactive to July 1,2000 for beneficiaries of certain publics afety officers killed in the line of duty prior to July 1,2000; such payments are retroactive to the date of the publics afety officers, and the spouses and dependents of such public safety officers, disabled in the line of duty on or after July 1,2000, the health in surance payments are retroactive to the first date that the disability existed. DPB cannot estimate with precision any fiscal impact associated with this bill because it would depend on the number of individuals who would become eligible for this benefit under the Line of Duty Act.
