4. Title Determining speed of vehicle with various devices.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Determining speed of vehicle with various devices; certificate as to accuracy of device. Provides that in any court in which any question arises about the calibration or accuracy of any vehicle speed determination device, a certificate showing the calibration or accuracy of any method employed in calibrating or testing any radar, laser, microcomputer or other speed determination device is admissible evidence. Currently, there is no specific provision for allowing laser calibrations into evidence.

8. Fiscal implications:

No, the Department of State Police currently has a program for testing, calibrating and certifying speed determination devices.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:

Those specific jurisdictions permitted to use a laser, microcomputer and/or other speed determination devices per §46.2 -882 that do not currently have a procedure for testing, calibrating and certifying the devices may be adversely impacted.
